This whole process has been quite an education for all of us. Restoring and preserving a structure that sits in the middle of the water, especially a square one, creates many unique (and expensive!) challenges. The engineering and construction planning process has revealed that restoring the upper Lighthouse structure, lower foundation and new rip-rap barrier simultaneously is the most cost effective route. This requires an immediate and additional \$100,000 to fully fund the expanded first phase of work now planned for the end of the 2015 boating season.

To raise these necessary funds and continue to fund other objectives of the \$1.5 million Capital Campaign, our great friend **Bernadette Castro** has launched **The Beacon Society** as a new fundraising drive. *Beacon Society* donors would pledge \$2,000 as a challenge grant to friends, family and business associates. Those who accept, contribute either \$500, \$1,000 or the full \$2,000 as a match.
